We require volunteer help in the maintenance and development of the Visitor Centre plant collections and gardens. Our key garden features are:

- One of the largest wildflower collections in UK, incl. a Tree Trail with most of Britain's native trees.
- Demonstration vegetable patch
- Sensory Garden
- Willow Walk, with over 200 varieties
- Native variety orchard



These collections are still in their early stages providing scope for volunteers to shape their future development.
